HARRISBURG – The board of the Pennsylvania State Employees' Retirement System today approved several key documents as part of its comprehensive governance manual.

The board adopted two key policies, amended bylaws, six committee charters and several position descriptions as part of a comprehensive governance manual. The governance manual is the product of a multi-year project to evaluate board structure and policies, as well as industry best practices, and to establish an enhanced framework for the board's structure, committees, duties and responsibilities.
