# b. <u>Securities Litigation Policy – Discussion of Claims Filings, Monitoring Services, Case</u> Evaluation Services, and Loss Thresholds

- Staff provided an update on the finalization of the RFP for the establishment of a Securities Litigation pool.
- Staff provided various recommendations to amend the Securities Litigation Policy, with regard to claims filing, case monitoring, case evaluation, and loss thresholds. After discussion, it was determined that staff will present to the Committee for its review at the next Committee meeting a draft revised Securities Litigation Policy that will provide for one provider for claims filing and case monitoring services. Staff will also revise the Securities Litigation Policy for the Committee's review at the next committee meeting, consistent with the direction given by the Committee to staff, to utilize one consultant for providing case evaluation services. Finally, a revised draft policy will include revisions to the loss thresholds, to be as follows:

Lead or Co-lead Plaintiff Status - \$10,000,000.

Opt-out Litigation - \$7,500,000.

Joining in a Foreign or Domestic Joint, Group or other Available Non-Class Action Litigation - \$1,000,000.

The Committee advised that it supports the direction and proposed revisions to the Securities Litigation Policy.
